LENTEN REGULATIONS

Good Friday is a day of **Abstinence from meat** & also of **Fasting**, which is limiting oneself to one full meal and two smaller meals in the course of the day with no snacking in between. **All other Fridays** of Lent are days of Abstinence from meat. The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics 14 years of age or older. The obligation to fast binds Catholics from 18-59.

LENTEN DAILY ADORATION:

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in church for Adoration at 6:00 AM on the weekdays of Lent, starting on Thursday, February 19. There will be concluding community prayers offered just before the start of the 6:30 AM Mass. Come spend some time in prayer with our Eucharistic Lord Jesus.
